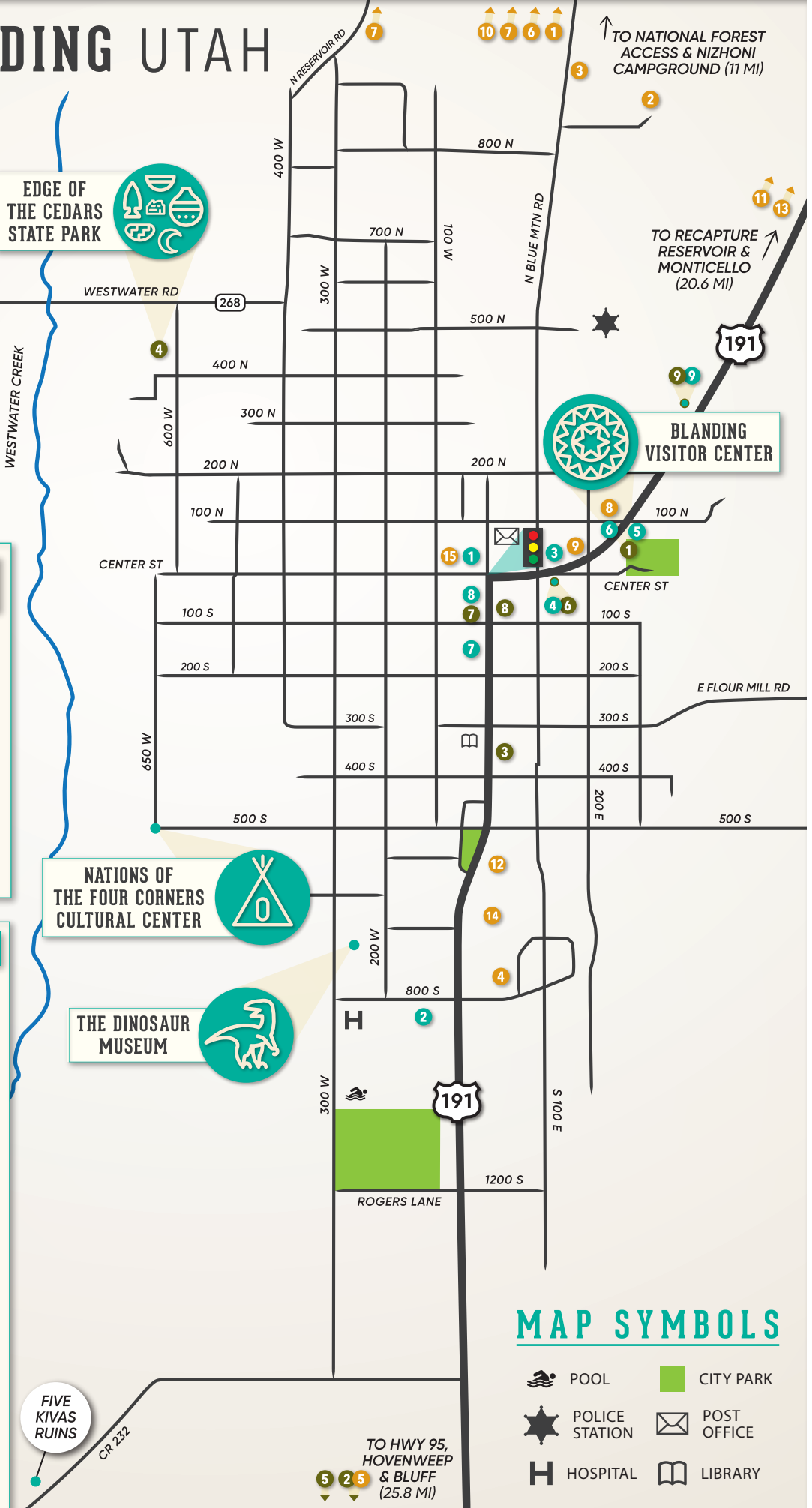

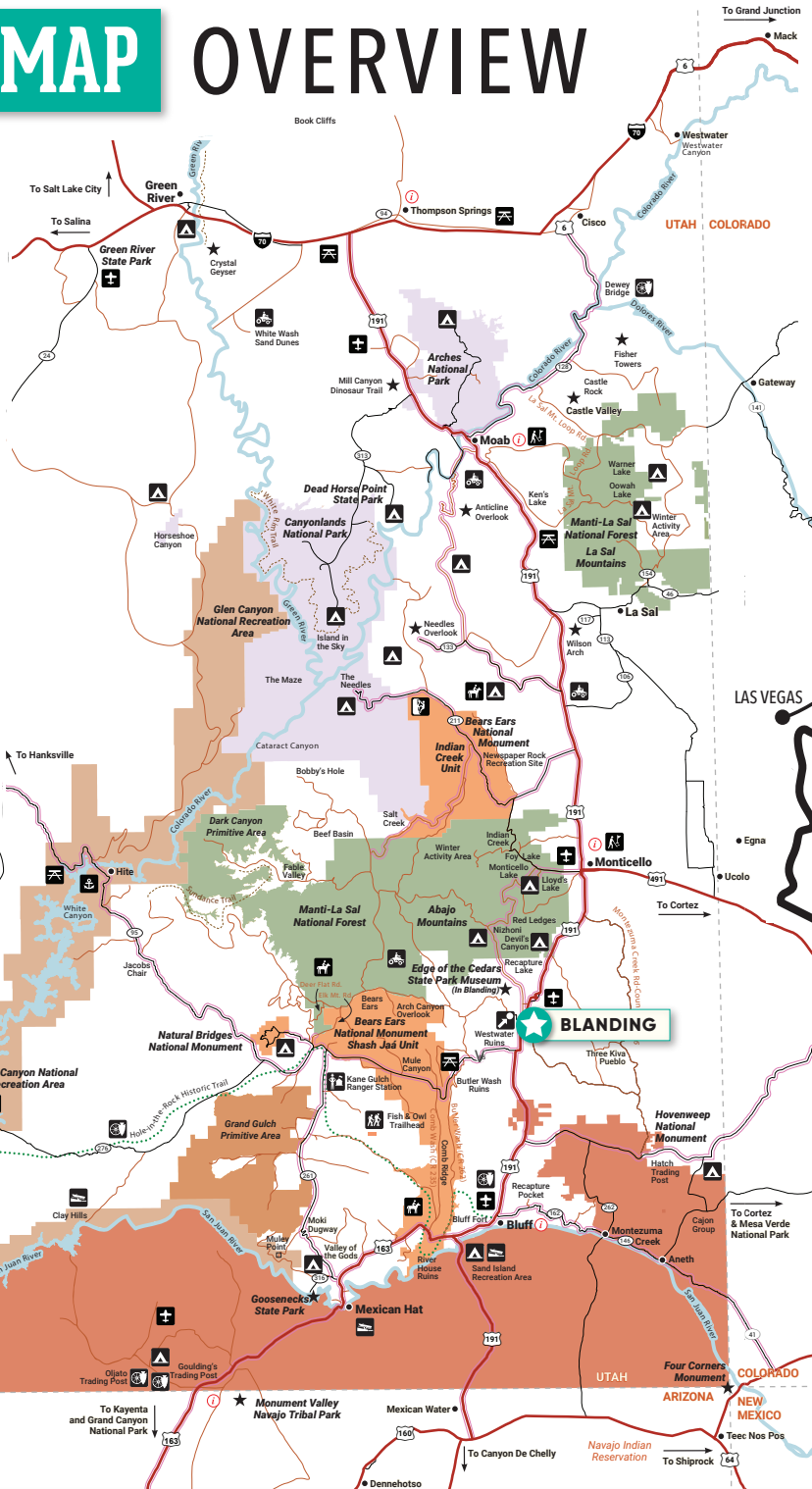

GETTING AROUND IN CANYON COUNTRY

Most areas and sites are on paved roads, some accessed via graded gravel, and a few require 4-wheel drive. Most are within a short drive from our communities.

Those areas accessed by 4-wheel drive may require long days or overnight stays. Prepare for a wilderness experience. It is not recommended that you travel to remote sites alone or with only one vehicle. When wet, some roads are impassable even for a 4-wheel vehicle. Check weather and road conditions prior to a trip into the backcountry.
