- Developing and upholding a positive workplace safety culture that requires all workers to take responsibility for their health and safety, and that of their fellow workers
- Implement, maintain, and continually improve our Workplace Health & Safety Management System accordance with ISO 45001
- Set health and safety objectives and targets (within QM-R-04 Objective, Targets & Improvement Programmes, which are reviewed at management review meetings) to drive continual improvement
- Report on health and safety performance, initiatives, and achievements
- Ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, consistent safety practices and behaviours across all business activities to eliminate hazards and reduce risks
- Ensure the management of health and safety issues is a fundamental component of the companies' objectives and targets, and to regularly review our progress with focus to achieve set targets
- Fulfill legislative and other requirements striving to exceed the workplace health and safety expectations
 of our clients and stakeholders
- Mandate participation in appropriate Work, Health & Safety training and encourage active participation in health promotion programs
- Ensure effective consultation and communication with the workforce to improve safety performance
- Ensure senior management actively participate, encourage, and promote health and safe practices at all times
