


Daily Decision Support Briefing

Maximum Wind Gust Tonight



What To Expect

Warm with mostly rain through Thursday

- Winter Weather Advisory remains in effect for light freezing rain across the upper Kennebec Valley this morning
- ✓ Some snowpack loss is expected, especially across southern and coastal locations, but the interior snowpack is expected to mostly hold
- ✓ River rises are expected to be modest and flooding is not anticipated at this time, though some ice break-up and ice jams are possible
- ✓ Strong southerly wind gusts around 45 to 50 mph are expected for Midcoast Maine and a <u>Wind Advisory</u> has been issued for tonight

Westerly winds may gust up to 45 mph areawide on Friday

Cooler with rain and snow showers late week through the weekend
