



Snowfall Mon Night through Tue

OVERVIEW:

- Low pressure passes south of Cape Cod and the Gulf of Maine late tonight and Tuesday, with accumulating snow overspreading a portion of the region.
- Greatest accumulations are expected in southernmost NH and York County ME.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Snow begins late tonight with light accumulations by the Tuesday morning commute in the south.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Storm Watch issued for southern NH into York County where confidence is greatest for 6 or more inches of snow. ▪ There will be a sharp south to north gradient in snowfall. ▪ A Coastal Flood Watch has been issued for Tuesday. ▪ Storm tides may reach minor flood stage Casco Bay to the NH Seacoast this afternoon. Water levels will increase Tuesday with minor to locally moderate coastal flooding from Portland south. ▪ Gusty NW winds develop behind the system Tue night into Wed.
