



Snowfall Mon Night through Tue

OVERVIEW:

- Low pressure passes south of Cape Cod and the Gulf of Maine late tonight and Tuesday, with accumulating snow overspreading a portion of the region.
- Greatest accumulations are expected in southernmost NH and York County ME.

TIMING	 Snow begins late tonight with light accumulations by the Tuesday morning commute in the south.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Winter Storm Watch issued for southern NH into York County where confidence is greatest for 6 or more inches of snow. There will be a sharp south to north gradient in snowfall. A Coastal Flood Watch has been issued for Tuesday. Storm tides may reach minor flood stage Casco Bay to the NH Seacoast this afternoon. Water levels will increase Tuesday with minor to locally moderate coastal flooding from Portland south. Gusty NW winds develop behind the system Tue night into Wed.
