



OVERVIEW:

- Fast moving storm system tracking out of the Great Lakes will bring snow Saturday night into Sunday
- Winter Storm Watch issued for southern New Hampshire
- Travel will be difficult at times Saturday Night into much of Sunday

TIMING

- Saturday evening through midday Sunday

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Southern and central New Hampshire and portions of southern Maine have a 40-70% chance of 6" of more snowfall
- Snowfall rates of 1" per hour are possible around midnight Saturday night over southern New Hampshire
- Snow character is NOT expected to be wet/sticky or cling to trees and power lines

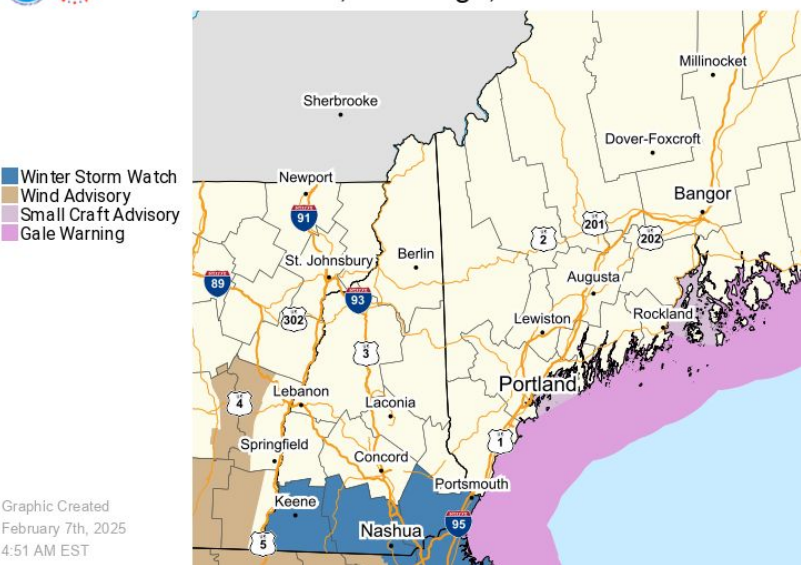
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

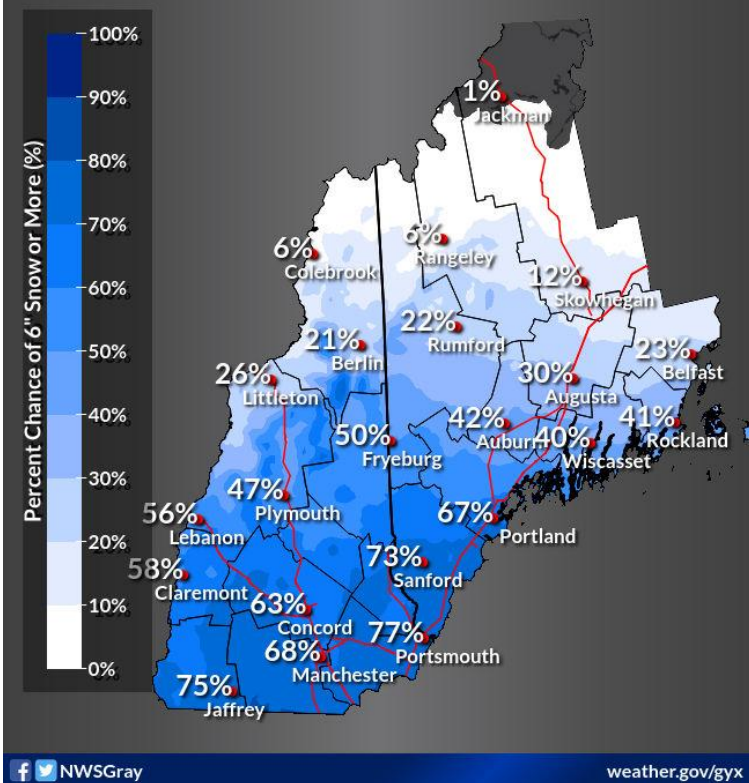
