


Daily Decision Support Briefing

Probability For At Least 6 Inches of Snow



What To Expect

Cloudier today and Tuesday, remaining mild and dry.

Complex storm system approaches Wednesday, will have the most impact Wednesday night into Thursday. Accumulating snow likely with heavy accumulations possible. Heaviest precipitation rates Wednesday night and Thursday morning. Sleet not out of the question at times in southern NH

- and coastal ME.
- Snow may be on the wet/heavy side especially south of the mountains and on the coast. This could cause power outages.
- Gusty to damaging winds toward the coast and over the coastal waters.
- Minor coastal flooding and splash-over possible.
- Depending on track of the storm, snow amounts, and snow water content, moderate to major impacts will be possible in terms of snowfall rates, amounts, and snow load (weight).
