

SEDONA'S NON-U.S. FOREST SERVICE LAND VIEWPOINTS BY MOTORCOACH

AIRPORT SCENIC OVERLOOK

On top of Airport Road with great views of Coffee Pot Rock, Sugar Loaf, Thunder Mountain, Chimney Rock, Cockscomb and more. Airport Scenic Overlook is a very popular viewpoint for spectacular Sedona sunsets.

JORDAN HISTORIC PARK

Located on Jordan Road in Uptown Sedona, this five-acre park is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and offers an opportunity to visit the Sedona Heritage Museum, take a short hike, or enjoy a picnic in a beautiful green space.

POSSE GROUNDS PARK

Located off State Route 89A on Posse Grounds Road in West Sedona, this is the largest community park providing a variety of recreational opportunities including an outdoor performance venue surrounded by red rock views.

RED ROCK STATE PARK

Various ranger programs can be arranged or operators can lead their own hiking tours for groups and individuals. Click <u>here</u> to learn more about Red Rock State Park.

SLIDE ROCK STATE PARK

Historic farming equipment, local apples during harvest, and a slippery water ride down the red rocks in Oak Creek. Great place to include in your itinerary during Summer and Fall. Click <u>here</u> to learn more about Slide Rock State Park.

UPTOWN SEDONA

Motorcoach parking is limited in Uptown Sedona, although some spots are available at Piñon Pointe and Sedona Center shopping centers. Loading/unloading area is located on Jordan Road in the public parking lot.

BELL ROCK VISTA AND PATHWAY

Great views of Bell Rock and Courthouse Butte (Limited to one motorcoach at a time)
Located between Sedona and the Village of Oak Creek near mile post 308 on State Route 179

OAK CREEK VISTA

A panoramic view of the Oak Creek Canyon and the red rocks of Sedona Located on top of Oak Creek Canyon between Sedona and Flagstaff near mile post 390 on State Route 89A

INCIDENTAL STOPS

Commercial buses and tours may make incidental stops on U.S. Service Forest land if:

- Stops are short in nature (approximately 15 minutes)
- · Are not scheduled specifically on the tour
- · Are at the request or need of the tour participants (i.e. restroom break, 'to stretch my legs')
- · No guided services are permitted
