Southern Utah features all sorts of contrasting, amazing, and beautiful geography all in an area larger than the state of Tennessee.

63 percent of Utah is public land. This includes the "Mighty Five": Arches, Canyonlands, Bryce, Zion, and Capitol Reef. Utah also has eight national monuments, five of which are in the southern part of Utah as well. To add to this natural playground, seven state parks call southern Utah home.

Native Americans knew there was something special about this place, as this area has one of the highest concentrations of Ancestral Puebloan artifacts found anywhere.
